Registration is from 4:30pm to 8:30pm on Friday. An optional supper will be served on Friday night at 5:15 pm for an additional cost. Please pre-register for this meal on the registration form or by contacting the office.

Camp ends on Monday with a special Thanksgiving Worship Service at 11:00am and a Traditional Thanksgiving Dinner at 12:30pm.

You will be served by our year-round staff team, and volunteers. The speaker, retreat hosts, musicians and children's program leaders are as yet to be announced.

Thanksgiving weekend runs from Friday evening through to Monday afternoon including a full course turkey dinner! This adult and family retreat is a tradition at IAWAH. The weekend is designed to provide a balance of organized activities and free time. Some of the activities that you can anticipate include climbing, canoeing, archery, the high ropes challenge course, and as always fun, family-oriented games. You are welcome to participate in as much or as little of the program as you like. Just after breakfast on Saturday and Sunday the worship team will start the day and age appropriate Bible study time follows for all (nursery care is provided).

Thanksgiving Monday

Thanksgiving Monday is a special time to celebrate God's goodness with a thankful heart. His handiwork surrounds us in the rich colours of fall. This morning we will gather to worship through music. Many of the IAWAH family will join us just for the day and we will be able to hear stories and see pictures of IAWAH's summer ministry. Service in the gym at 11:00am followed by a traditional turkey dinner at 12:30pm & 1:45pm.

Accommodations :

IAWAH Lodge or Bush Lodge. The rooms in IAWAH Lodge are furnished with bunk beds and there are centrally located, dormitory-style wash rooms with showers. The rooms in Bush Lodge are furnished with a combination of double beds and bunk beds. Each room has its own ensuite washroom with a shower.

Bedding and towels are not provided.

Meals:

Approximately 10 minutes before each meal, a bell is rung to announce that it is time to make your way to the Dining Hall. All of your meals will be provided by our excellent cooks. Meals are served "family-style" with a volunteer from each table serving as the "hopper". The "hopper" brings the meal to the table and makes sure that the table always has what it needs. Please include on your registration form any food allergies/ special dietary needs.

Medical Care:

Guests are responsible for their own medical care. There is a pharmacy in nearby Westport if you need any supplies, but we would recommend that you bring Band-Aids, cough/cold/allergy remedy, Tylenol/Advil, and any prescription medication that you need.

How to Register:

Registration forms are available online at www.iawah.com or by calling the camp office at 613-273-5621. A \$100.00 deposit is required to confirm registration. Forms may be submitted by email, fax or postal mail.

Weekend Fees:

Friday evening to Monday lunch: \$160/adult, Children 7 and up \$115, Children 6 and under- no charge. Family maximum \$500 (all fees include HST). Optional Friday supper (served 5:15 pm): \$10/adult and \$5/child

Directions:

From Brockville, proceed north on Hwy 29 and then west along Hwy 42 to Westport. In Westport turn left on Bedford St.
From Ottawa, travel west on Hwy 7 to Perth. Turn left on to Wilson Street, at Foster Street turn left, and then right on to Gore Street. Turn right onto County Rd 10 (Scotch Line) to Westport.

In Westport turn right on Bedford St. From Westport, travel west on Bedford St (also known as Salem Rd) through town (becomes County. Rd. 12) west to the flashing light at Fermoy.

From Hwy 401 west of Kingston or from Hwy 7 west of Sharbot Lake, travel to Godfrey on Hwy 38 and follow Westport Rd east to the flashing light at Fermoy.

At Fermoy (flashing light) turn north on Lee Rd. Travel 0.5 km and turn right on IAWAH Rd, and then follow the signs 3 km further to IAWAH.
