Labour Day Family Retreat

The weekend is designed to provide a balance of organized activities and free time. Some activities you can anticipate include: climbing, canoeing, archery, the high ropes challenge course, and as always fun, family-oriented games. You are welcome to participate in as much or as little of the program as you like. Just after breakfast on Saturday and Sunday the worship team will start the day and age appropriate Bible study time follows for all. Nursery care is provided.

About our Speaker

Our speaker for this weekend is Dave Harder. After 13 years in campus ministry and helping with two church plants he moved his family to Ottawa in 2008. Dave is the lead Pastor of The Journey, a missional church that has a desire to see a city transformed one neighbourhood at a time -- and to see the Kingdom of God become tangible where people live, play and work. He is married to Kari and has three children; Emily (9), Kellan (6), and Kayla (3).

Accommodations:

Bush Lodge, Derbyshire Lodge, or summer camper cabins. The rooms in Bush Lodge are furnished with a combination of double beds and bunk beds. Each room has its own ensuite washroom with a shower. The rooms in Derbyshire Lodge are also furnished with a combination of double beds and bunk beds and have centrally located, dormitory-style wash rooms with showers. Cabins are simple and basic spaces equipped with up to five bunk beds and a small outdoor porch. Within walking distance is a central washhouse equipped with flush toilets and showers. Families need to bring bedding, pillows and towels for all accommodation.

Meals:

Approximately 10 minutes before each meal, a bell is rung to announce that it is time to make your way to the Dining Hall. Hearty meals with lots of choice are provided by IAWAH staff. Meals are served "family-style" with a volunteer from each table serving as the "hopper". The "hopper" brings the meal to the table and makes sure that the table always has what it needs. Please include on your registration form any food allergies/special dietary needs.

Medical Care:

Guests are responsible for their own medical care. There is a pharmacy in nearby Westport if you need any supplies. Please bring Band-Aids, cough/cold/allergy remedy, Tylenol/Advil, and any prescription medication needed.

How to Register:

Registration forms are available online at www.iawah.com or by calling the camp office at 613-273-5621. A \$100.00 deposit is required to confirm registration. Forms may be submitted by email, fax or postal mail.

Cost:

If paying full fees before May 1st (including 3% PST and 5% GST) \$160/adult, \$115/children and teens, no charge for 6 years and under. Family Max: \$500

If paying after May 1st, 13% HST applies \$167.41/adult, \$120.32/children and teens; Family Max. \$523.15

Add Friday Supper (\$10/adult, \$5/child) – tax included.
