# Winter Family Retreat

The weekend is designed to provide a balance of organized activities and free time. Some of the activities that you can anticipate include wall climbing, tubing, indoor archery, broomball, and as always fun, family-oriented games. You are welcome to participate in as much or as little of the program as you like. Registration begins as early as 4pm on Friday; an optional supper will be served at 5:15pm for those planning to arrive prior to supper.

Please pre-register if you are planning to join us for the Friday supper. An evening snack will be provided for all families later Friday evening. Just after breakfast on Saturday and Sunday the worship team will start the day – an age-appropriate Bible teaching follows for all. Nursery care is also provided. Afternoons are for outdoor recreation and for IAWAH led activities. Evenings include fun indoor games, recreation in the gymnasium or a group game for adults. Evenings are great opportunities for family times and games in the dining room. An evening snack is provided.

## About this Weekend:

Our hosts are Will & Pauline French, together with their four children (ages 7-14) of Portland, Ontario. Will teaches at Rideau District High School and coaches community basketball. Pauline stays home full time and helps with the children and youth ministry at their church. IAWAH has played an important role in nurturing their family and faith, giving their children opportunities to grow through summer camps and family retreats.

Our Speaker for this retreat is Dave Harder. After 13 years of campus ministry and helping with two church plants in Calgary and Vancouver, Dave and his family moved to Ottawa in 2008. Dave is the Lead Pastor of The Journey, a missional church with a desire to see a city transformed one neighbourhood at a time -- and to see the Kingdom of God become tangible where people live, play and work. He also serves on the SLT (Servant Leadership Team) of Mission Ottawa helping followers of Jesus to live out Mission in the city. He is married to Kari and has three children; Emily (11), Kellan (8), and Kayla (5).

## Arrival and Registration:

Registration is from 4pm to 8pm on Friday night. Please check in at IAWAH Lodge to pay any outstanding fees and to confirm your room assignment. Supper for pre-registered guests will be served at 5:15pm. A short orientation to the weekend will take place in the dining hall at 8:30pm.

## Departure:

The weekend ends with a lovely brunch on Monday at 9:15am. Families are welcome to stay a little longer for the last tube run or skate on Monday; however, check out time is 12 noon.

## Accommodations:

IAWAH Lodge or Bush Lodge.

The rooms in IAWAH Lodge are furnished with bunk beds and there are centrally located, dormitory-style wash rooms with showers. The rooms in Bush Lodge are furnished with a combination of double beds and bunk beds. Each room has its own ensuite washroom with a shower. Bedding and towels are not provided.

## Meals:

Approximately 10 minutes before each meal, a bell is rung to announce that it is time to make your way to the Dining Hall. All of the meals will be provided by our excellent cooks. Meals are served "family-style" with a volunteer from each table serving as the "hopper". The "hopper" brings the meal to the table and makes sure that the table always has what it needs.

## Medical Care:

Guests are responsible for their own medical care. There is a pharmacy in nearby Westport if you need any supplies, but we would recommend that you bring Band-Aids, cough/cold/allergy remedy, Tylenol/Advil, and any prescription medication that you need.

## How to Register:

Registration forms are available online at [www.iawah.com](http://www.iawah.com) or by calling the camp office at 613-273-5621. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required to confirm registration. Forms may be submitted by email, fax or postal mail. Cost: \$175/adult, \$125/children age 7 & up, no charge for children 6 years and under. Family Max: \$575. Optional Friday Supper: \$10/adult and \$5/child (ages 7 and up). All fees quoted include 13% HST.

## Directions:

From Brockville, proceed north on Hwy 29 and then west along Hwy 42 to Westport. In Westport, turn left on Bedford St. From Ottawa, travel west on Hwy 7 to Perth. Turn left on to Wilson Street, at Foster Street turn left, and then right on to Gore Street. Turn right onto County Rd 10 (Scotch Line) to Westport. In Westport, turn right on Bedford St.

From Westport, travel west on Bedford St (also known as Salem Rd) through town (becomes County Rd. 12) west to the flashing light at Fermoy.

From Hwy 401 west of Kingston or from Hwy 7 west of Sharbot Lake, travel to Godfrey on Hwy 38 and follow Westport Rd east to the flashing light at Fermoy.

At Fermoy (flashing light) turn north on Lee Rd. Travel 0.5 km and turn right on IAWAH Rd, and then follow the signs 3 km further to IAWAH.
