



Position: Cabin Leader (2-9 week seasonal contract) (28 positions - 14 male, 14 female)

Compensation: \$100-\$250/week plus room & board benefit

Effective: June 24 - August 25, 2012 (1 week training, 5 weeks max. in cabin, 3 weeks other)

Camp IAWAH seeks Cabin Leaders to serve in its Summer Camping Ministry. These positions are ideal for individuals who are interested in demonstrating the love of God and caring for children and youth through small group residence experiences.

Under the direction of the Camping and Leadership Director, the successful candidates will have a heart for children and youth and be able to effectively create a small group environment that allows each camper to be safe, interact in a healthy way with each other, have incredible fun and discover the love of God.

In addition to residential care, Cabin Leaders typically lead one to two activity periods each day. During weeks, when not in cabin, cabin leaders are assigned to other roles within Camp. Training, as necessary, is provided.

The successful candidates will have:

- a love for children and youth as a demonstration of love for God;
- the awareness and ability to care for the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of individual campers including supervision, meals and night time care;
- the ability to care for campers when tired or feeling uninspired;
- the ability to facilitate a small group - valuing each individual, drawing out of each camper what they are discovering, teaching when necessary and making sense of it all;
- the experience and character necessary to ensure right camper behaviour while maintaining quality relationships;
- signed IAWAH's Statement of Faith, Lifestyle Agreement and Commitment to Team;
- an acceptable reference and background check, including Police Records Check/Vulnerable Persons Sector Check.

In addition, the following will be considered assets:

- previous successful experience cabin leading;
- Standard First Aid with CPR "C";
