



Position: Camp Medical Personnel - (per week)

Camp IAWAH seeks an individual with a heart for IAWAH's Camping Ministry to provide medical/first aid care to campers and staff. This position is ideal for nurse(s) and/or doctor(s) who have a week or two to volunteer their medical/first aid skills and training to ensure that Camp is a safe and successful Christian experience.

Under the direction of the Director of Administration and in cooperation with the Camping & Leadership Director, the successful candidate will be responsible for the health and safety of the Camp experience. This includes being able to assess the medical needs of campers and staff and respond appropriately. The ability to knowledgeably and professionally dispense prescriptions and medications is required.

Training is provided. Annually updated "Standing Doctor's Orders" are provided for nurses. Medical history for campers and staff is provided.

The successful candidates will have:

- the ability to function successfully in a fast paced, multitasking environment;
- a current license to practise medicine in Ontario;
- excellent assessment skills specific to children, youth and young adult needs;
- medical malpractice insurance;
- the ability to be a team player within the various staff teams including advising staff on health and safety issues;
- signed IAWAH's Statement of Faith, Lifestyle Agreement and Commitment to Team;
- an acceptable reference and background check, including Police Records Check/Vulnerable Persons Sector Check.

In addition, the following will be considered assets:

- previous experience in emergency or pediatric care;
- knowledge of common behaviour control medications;
- the ability to lead Bible studies and/or worship leading experience.
