



Position: Canoe Trip Leader (1-9 week seasonal contract) (4-6 positions)

Compensation: \$150-\$300/week plus room & board benefit

Effective: June 24 - August 25, 2012 (1 week training, 8 weeks delivery)

Camp IAWAH seeks four to six Canoe Trip Staff to serve in its Out There and Youth Development and Leadership Programs. These positions are ideal for post secondary students who are interested in being a "guide", introducing children and youth to the outdoors and using the wilderness as a platform for learning about God and developing leadership skills.

Successful candidates will have a heart for children and youth. Under the direction of the Out There Team Leader, they will be able to effectively engage them in Christian wilderness community, model good habits and teach wilderness living and paddling skills.

Training is provided. Staff may alternate between the roles of being the Trip Leader and Assistant Leader. When staff are not on trip, they may be assigned to other roles on-site at Camp.

The successful candidates will have:

- a love for children and youth as a demonstration of love for God;
- the ability to function successfully and safely while caring for campers 24/7 in the wilderness;
- demonstrated the ability to correctly balance enforcing safety standards while remaining relationally strong;
- current NLS, WFA, MW1a, LW1a and CT2;
- signed IAWAH's Statement of Faith, Lifestyle Agreement and Commitment to Team;
- an acceptable reference and background check, including Police Records Check/Vulnerable Persons Sector Check.

In addition, the following will be considered assets:

- previous successful experience leading trips;
- enrollment in post secondary education related to recreation and the outdoors;
