



**Position: Prime Time and Worship Coordinator (9-10 week seasonal contract)**

This includes using a variety of resources and tools such as music, spoken word, scripture, reflection, and celebration. The ability to hear and obey God's voice, co-ordinate resources, and work cohesively with guest speakers is necessary.

Training is provided. Time allocation: Prime Time and Worship Coordinator 50% - 65%, Secondary Role 35% - 50%.

The successful candidates will have:

- the ability to function creatively and dynamically with a variety of band teams and different speakers every week;
- the experience necessary to discern and implement what is necessary to successfully lead others in worship;
- the ability to be a team player within the various staff teams;
- a spirit of gentleness and submission before God and His Word;
- signed IAWAH's Statement of Faith, Lifestyle Agreement and Commitment to Team;
- an acceptable reference and background check, including Police Records Check/Vulnerable Persons Sector Check.

In addition, the following will be considered assets:

- the ability to sing and/or play a musical instrument;
- drama and/or theatre experience;
- the ability to lead Bible studies and/or teach Truth to others;
- current NLS or Bronze Cross;
- certifications and/or experience in teaching camp activities.
